Voting was extremely, and nail-bitingly, close right up to the final hour. We'd been in 20th place on Monday, and were creeping up the scoreboard each day. Parents and friends were sending the link to vote to friends in far places like England, Ireland, Hawaii, Texas, Dubai...and even Australia!

We also had amazing support from Arbutus Middle School, the Arbutus Childrens' Centre, the Queen Alexandra Hospital, Torquay, Marigold PAC and Saanich News....to name just a few of the many that helped along the way.
