ACTIVE AND SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL


Frank Hobbs Elementary is excited to be part of the **Active and Safe Routes to School** 2018-19 program. This program encourages,
motivates and supports children and their families to safely walk, bike or roll to and from school.

This year Frank Hobbs parents will be invited to complete an on-line survey and attend a neighbourhood walkabout. The program will identify active transportation challenges near the school to inform future street improvements. A Best Routes map will share our students' favourite routes to get to school by bike or foot.

Active travel is a great way to support your child's increased physical activity. Students that get more physical activity are more creative, better able to solve problems and have longer attention spans during school. They are also less likely to have depression and anxiety.

The Active and Safe Routes to School program is funded by the District of Saanich and delivered by the Capital Regional District.
