The reasons we've made this change to a new menu include: to provide fresh, healthy meals for our students, eliminate packaging and waste on special lunch days, and to reduce pressure on volunteers.

When you log on to place your orders, you'll see a huge variety of meals, prepared by Peppers especially for us using fresh, local ingredients.

Because this is a brand new program with a learning curve for all of us, we've kept it very simple. We've reduced the number of options to the bare essentials. However, students with dietary needs that restrict them from eating off our regular menu will not be left out or offered something that they shouldn't eat.
