Hello everyone,

You are being sent this message because you have asked to be kept informed and/or have been involved at some point during the process of creating the Haro Woods Park Management Plan. I am writing to let you know that the final draft plan is now complete.

The plan recommends no changes to the park's current P4-N (Natural Park) zoning, which allows passive recreation such as walking, bird watching, dog walking, and recreational family cycling. Off-trail biking and trail and jump building is a form of active recreation and as such is not permitted in the park. Haro Woods Park's passive recreation will be accommodated by a minimal trail system and benches, and enhanced with educational and interpretive signs.

Parks staff will present the plan to Council on December 10, 2018. This is a public meeting and you are welcome to attend.
