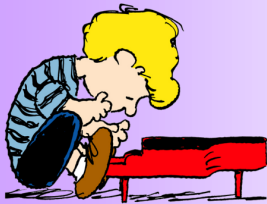

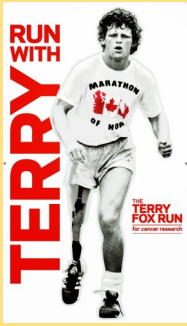

Please drop off any donations into the “Donations” bin outside of the LLC.

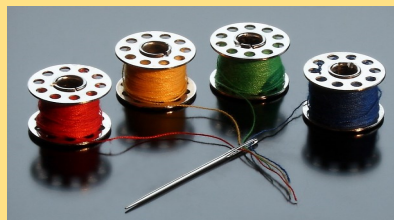
