## **BC RESTART PLAN IS IN STAGE 3**

The Ministry of Education has a five-stage approach for resuming in-class instruction in a measured way to align with [B.C.'s Restart Plan](#).

Each stage will be guided by health and safety guidelines, measures, protocols and orders as well as the principles developed for continuity of learning.
