2023/2024 School Supplies – Important information and ordering deadlines for families



Our PAC has been working hard to look at some changes to school supplies. For Kindergarten students, this process will be different from previous years.

For students entering grades 1-5 in September, we will be using Monk Office to supply kits. Parents can order supplies through Monk's as in previous years. Please see the attachment below for the Monk's order.

What Grade 1 to 5 parents need to know:

 \bullet Visit $\underline{bts.monk.ca}$ and enter your PAC Code: 278564 on the SHOP page

• All items are optional so you can order what you need. Please review the <u>school supply</u> <u>list</u> to determine quantities needed.

• If you place your order by the **DEADLINE of July 19th**, Monk's will contribute a portion of the proceeds to the PAC to support school programs, and they will deliver directly to the school.

For students entering Kindergarten in September:

We will be running a trial of a new whole-class school supply ordering system. Supplies will be ordered in bulk and delivered directly to Kindergarten teachers.

By purchasing supplies in bulk, the PAC will help parents save money and time, as they will not need to buy supplies individually and we pass the bulk savings to families.

What Kindergarten parents need to know:

Please do not buy school supplies

• All required supplies for Kindergarten students will be ordered and delivered to classroom teachers by the PAC directly

• Kindergarten parents will be asked to make a donation to the PAC in September through the hot lunch platform to cover the cost of their child's supplies – Kindergarten parents will receive more information about this directly.
