#### Daylight Savings Time:

Please remember to turn your clocks ahead one hour when you go to bed on Saturday March 9<sup>th</sup>, as we spring forward into Daylight Savings Time officially early on Sunday, March 10<sup>th</sup>.

#### Spring Break:

Our District's Spring Break is from March 18th to April 2<sup>nd</sup>. **Classes resume Wednesday April 3<sup>rd</sup>**. All SD61 schools will be closed over the Spring Break.

#### Attendance:

Regular attendance is very important. A student's over-all growth increases significantly over the time when they attend school regularly and have strong connections to all aspects of classroom and school learning.

When your child misses 2 days of school a month, that equates to 20 days a year: 30 hours of math, and 60 hours of reading and writing. Research shows there is a powerful link between successful learning and regular school attendance.

While we recognize students may be periodically absent from school due to illness or important family plans and trips, *please support your child by working hard to attend school regularly and arrive on time.*
