Pink Shirt Day:

Pink Shirt Day is the day we bring more awareness to the issue of bullying in our schools and workplaces. We do this to discuss ways to be kind to one another, and to actively create a more inclusive environment for everyone. *We encourage everyone to wear pink on Wednesday February 25th.* We strive to create a welcoming and inclusive school where everyone feels valued. Everyday of the year, we embrace opportunities to teach and model these values, helping our community to grow stronger together.

Parking Safety at Frank Hobbs:

As the colder and wetter days continue, we typically see an increase in vehicle traffic around the school. We appreciate your efforts to help keep our children safe by reducing the number of vehicles whenever possible.

Frank Hobbs Elementary was designed with the vision of children walking or biking to their neighborhood school. Instead of driving up Haro Road to drop your child off directly in front of the school, please consider using one of the designated walk-to-school drop-off locations.

Each of these alternate drop-off points is less than a five-minute walk to the school. Not only does this encourage a bit of physical activity, but research also shows that even a short walk supports better learning and mental health. An easy drop-off option is along Hobbs Street, where you can use the pathway, or further down Haro Road.

STUDENT SAFETY is our top priority. It is crucial to obey the **NO PARKING** signs, this includes Staff Parking Spots, as parking space is extremely limited and in high demand during peak times. Many of our students walk, bike, or scooter to school, and some are small and unpredictable in their movements. We've had a few close calls between vehicles and students, and your cooperation in using designated drop-off zones and walking to school can help prevent accidents.

At Frank Hobbs Elementary, we are committed to being a good community member and appreciate the efforts each family makes to ensure safe and effective travel to and from school. Thank you for helping us create a safe, positive environment for everyone.

With many students taking busses for class field trips, we would like to remind everyone of the expected behaviour, so ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all.
